

When You Recycle, Everyone Wins

Paper Products

Corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes, newspaper, magazines, catalogs, computer paper, junk mail, phone books, paperboard & other paper products

- 1. Paper must be boxed, bundled or placed in a paper bag.
- 2. No wax paper, wax cups or wax milk cartons, fax paper or carbon paper are accepted.
- 3. Place paper in designated container.
- 4. DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS.

Aluminum Cans, Foil & Pie Pans

- 1. Must be empty and rinsed out.
- 2. May be crushed.
- 3. Deposit cans in proper bin.
- 4. Give foil & pie pans to attendant.

Clean Lumber & Wooden Pallets

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley centers only.
- 2. Wood with paint or stain not accepted.
- 3. Pressure treated lumber, rotted wood, furniture or laminated wood not accepted.

Bi-Metal, Steel, & Tin Cans

- 1. Must be empty and rinsed out.
- 2. May remove ends and flatten.
- 3. Test cans with magnet; if magnet sticks include with steel; if not include with aluminum cans.
- 4. Deposit in proper bin.

Appliances & Scrap Metal

Washers, dryers, stoves, window air conditioners, lawn mowers, chainsaws, dehumidifiers, aluminum, brass and copper are accepted.

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley Centers only.
- 2. Certain units containing freon are only accepted during special announced events. Call first.
- 3. No propane bottles are accepted.

Tires

1. Tires accepted at special events only. Please call.

Bicycles

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only.
- 2. Any age, condition or manufacture accepted.
- 3. Give to attendant.

Glass Bottles & Jars

Clear, brown, green, yellow & blue

- 1. Glass must be sorted by color.
- 2. Containers must be empty and rinsed out.
- 3. Lids and caps must be removed.
- 4. Gold glass goes in with brown glass.
- 5. Blue glass goes in with green glass.
- 6. Deposit in the proper bins.
- 7. No light bulbs, window glass, flat glass, cookware or dinner ware are accepted.

Yard Waste/Christmas Trees

Leaves, grass, brush, sawdust, weeds, vegetables, sod, flowers, Christmas trees & garden residue

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only.
- 2. Christmas trees must be free of lights and ornaments.
- 3. Yard waste may be commingled.
- 4. Brush must be less than 6 inches thick and less than 10 feet long. There is a processing fee for brush.
- 5. Stumps, food scraps, ashes or pressure treated wood not accepted.
- 6. Remove from plastic bag and deposit.

Plastic Milk & Soda Bottles

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley Centers only.
- 2. All colors accepted.
- 3. Must be stamped #1 or #2 on plastic bottles.
- 4. All lids must be removed and discarded.
- 5. Place bottles in clear see- through plastic bag.
- 6. Plastic bag provided free of charge upon request.
- 7. No oil bottles, antifreeze bottles, plastic trays, plastic toys, plastic tubs, buckets or styrofoam accepted.

Ink Jet and Toner Cartridges

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only
- 2. Give to attendant.

Compact Fluorescent Lamps

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only.
- 2. Place in a small plastic bag.
- 3. Do NOT break glass.
- 4. Deposit in proper area.
- 5. Long tube fluorescent lamps are not accepted.

Dry Cell, Lead Acid and

Rechargeable Batteries

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only.
- 2. Separate dry cell batteries from rechargeable batteries.
- 3. Place all dry cell and rechargeable batteries in a small plastic bag.
- 4. Deposit in proper area.

Books

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only.
- 2. Deposit hard or soft back books into yellow container marked "books".
- 3. No school yearbooks accepted.

Clothing

Clothes or other textiles of any age, condition or manufacture accepted.

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only.
- 2. Place in plastic bag and deposit in yellow containers.

Electronics

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley Centers only.
- 2. Cell phones, ink jet cartridges, toner cartridges and electrical wiring accepted.
- 3. TV's, computers, monitors, VCR's, and other electroncs are accepted at special events only. Please call.

Plastic Bags

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley Centers Only.
- 2. Bags must be labled with a recycling symbol #2 or #4.
- 3. Bags must be empty of orginal contents.
- 4. No trash or garbage bags accepted.

Shoes

- 1. Grapevine Road and South Berkeley sites only.
- 2. Any age, condition or manufacture accepted.
- 3. Place in plastic bag.
- 4. Deposit in yellow containers.
